Jeff Evans will play the bagpipes after Roberta Denton Irwin reads the Memorial List on Saturday evening.

Roger Ansel will search for the anthem for each branch of the armed service. The anthem will be played as each classmate will stand for his/her representative branch and remain standing as the anthem is played.
